- St. Joseph, Patron of the Order.
- Our Holy Father Augustine.
- St. Monica.
- All Saints of the Order.
- St. Nicholas of Tolentino.
- Anniversary of the Reform.
- Celebration of the General Chapter.

The Members of a **Community**:

- Patron/Patroness of the House.
- Saints or Blessed whose body or relic is preserved in the House or Church.
- On the occasion of the Canonical Visit.

To Single **Members**:

- On the day of the Investiture.
- On the day of the Simple Profession.
- On the day of the Solemn Profession.
- On the Jubilee anniversary of Profession and/or Ordination (25th; 50th; 60th; 75th).

Preamble no. 5

FASTING AND ABSTINENCE

The can. 1249 indicates that: "the divine law binds all the Christian faithful to do penance each in his or her own way. In order for all to be united among themselves by some common observance of penance, however, penitential days are prescribed on which the Christian faithful devote themselves in a special way to prayer, perform works of piety and charity, and deny themselves by fulfilling their own obligations more faithfully [...]".

The no. 39 of the *Directory* adds: "a) Fasting and abstinence from meat on all Fridays of the year and in the eves of St. Joseph (March 19), the Annunciation of the Lord (March 25), the Conversion of our Holy Father Augustine (April 24), the Mother of Consolation (September 4), the Immaculate Conception (December 8); b) Abstinence from meat on all Saturdays of Advent and Lent", as a peculiar characteristic of a mendicant Order.

Paul VI makes the following distinction in the Apostolic Constitution *Paenitemini* (February 17: 1966), to which particular personal and health situations make exceptions:

- <u>Fast</u>: it is the obligation to have a single complete meal during the day, reducing the amount of food in the morning and in the evening; all adults up to the age of sixty are required (can. 1252).
- Abstinence: it is the prohibition of the use of meat in meals; all those who have completed fourteen years are required (can. 1252).



IMPORTANT DATES IN OUR HISTORY

April 9, 1256: with the Bull *Licet Ecclesiae*, Pope Alexander IV approves the Great Union and establishes the Order of Hermits of Saint Augustine.

May 19, 1592: with the Decree *Et Quoniam Satis*, the 100th General Chapter OSA prescribes the Reform to all the Convents of the Order.

June 28, 1592: Fr. Andrea DIAZ, a reformed Augustinian from Spain, arrives at the Convent of Saint Augustine in Naples, and he unites with Fr. Andrea of SICIGNANO in the Convent of St. Maria of Olivella to start the reformed movement.

July 20, 1592: the first group of Discalced Augustinians put on the reformed habit in St. Maria of Olivella in Naples.

November 16, 1593: with the Decree *Cum Ordinis nostri splendorem*, Fr. Andrea SECURANI, OSA Prior General, juridically recognizes our Reform.

December 22, 1594: with the Breve *Decet Romanum Pontificem,* Pope Clement VIIII formally approves the Reform of the Discalced Augustinians.

April 27, 1598: the 1st General Chapter of our Reform, celebrated in San Paolo alla Regola in Rome, promulgates the first *Constitutions* and the *Ceremonials* of the Reform.

December 10, 1599: the Discalced Augustinians of the two Communities in Rome renewed their Profession in the hands of the of the Apostolic Superintendent, Fr. Peter of the Mother of God, OCD, adding for the very first time the fourth Vow of Humility at the Church of Santo Stefano Rotondo.

May 5, 1620: with the Breve *Sacri Apostolatus Ministerio*, Pope Paul V approves in a specific form the new *Constitutions* promulgated by the General Chapter of 1609.

March 1, 1697: Fr. Alfonso Romano of the Mother of God and Fr. Giovanni Mancini of Sts. Augustine and Monica left the Convent of Gesù and Maria to start the Oriental Missions: Tonkin and China.

IMPORTANT DATES

April 21, 1931: the Congregation of Religious approves the *Constitutions*, revised in accordance with the *Code of Canon Law* of 1917.

June 12, 1948: the Discalced Augustinians arrived in Rio de Janeiro (RJ), Brazil.

August 28, 1983: the Congregation of Religious and Secular Institutes approves the *Constitutions*, elaborated in accordance with the directives of the II Vatican Council and the *Code of Canon Law*.

August 2, 1994: the Discalced Augustinians arrived in Cebu City, Philippines.

April 8, 1997: the Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments approves the *Augustinian Liturgical Calendar*.

July 13, 1999: the 75th General Chapter extinguishes the four Italian Provinces and creates the Province of Italy: Madonna del Buon Consiglio.

July 13, 1999: the 75th General Chapter extinguishes the Delegation and creates the Province of Brazil: Santa Rita de Cássia.

August 14, 2004: the Discalced Augustinians started a mission in Bandung, Indonesia, with the blessing of the local Bishop.

July 18, 2005: the 76th General Chapter extinguishes the Delegation and creates the Philippine Province of Saint Nicholas of Tolentino.

January 22, 2007: the Discalced Augustinians arrived in Yguazú, Paraguay.

January 20, 2008: the Discalced Augustinians arrived in Bamenda, Cameroon.

May 4, 2008: the Discalced Augustinians arrived in Da Nang, Vietnam.

December 15, 2018: the Discalced Augustinians arrived in Nalgonda Diocese, India.

November 21, 2019: the Congregation of Religious approves the changes made to the Constitutions after the celebration of the 78th General Chapter.

May 22, 2023: The *Ritual* and the *Ratio Generalis Institutionis* are definitively promulgated.
